Release Overview

Chargent version 6.25 brings Flow-enabled functionality to our Take Payment Component, usable just about anywhere in Salesforce, including within the Experience Cloud. This release also delivers fixes and app refinements to our core product.



Major Feature Updates

Flow-Enabled Take Payment Component

Where: This applies to Chargent Orders v6.25

Our Take Payment Component can now be leveraged within Screen Flows, allowing you to quickly plug Chargent's payment collection functionality into even more use-cases and payment scenarios. These flows can be configured for your internal staff **or** your Experience Cloud customers. Adding and configuring our Take Payment Component within your Screen Flows takes just a couple of minutes, and can be done declaratively. No code, no developer needed!



Enhancements

Send Expired Card Data to Payment Gateways

Where: This applies to Chargent Orders, Cases, and Opportunities v6.25

Some payment gateways offer token update features wherein an expired card's token can still be used as long as the payment gateway has been provided with the updated card expiry date. This release now allows you to send transactions with expired card data so that you can take advantage of these gateway features, reducing payment interruptions within your Org.

Fixes

Payment Request Links Generation Failures - Fixed

Fixed an issue wherein Payment Request links would not properly generate if the user had the Chargent User (Orders) permission set assigned.

Payment Request Logo Images not Displaying - Fixed

Fixed an issue wherein Payment Request pages would not display the logo image in the Safari browser in Chargent v6.20.

Account Updater Logo Images not Displaying - Fixed

Fixed an issue wherein Account Updater pages would not display the logo image in Chargent v6.20.

Account Updater Field Updates not Mapping - Fixed

Fixed an issue wherein updates entered into the payform fields on the Account Updater page did not update those respective fields in Chargent Orders, Cases, or Opportunities in v.6.20.

“SELF_REFERENCE” Errors when Stopping or Editing an Automated Collections Process - Fixed

Fixed an issue wherein admins would receive emails indicating a ‘SELF_REFERENCE’ error when an Automated Collections Process was edited or manually stopped.

ACH Transactions in the Chargent Anywhere Payment Console - Fixed

Fixed an issue wherein, upon attempting to create a new recurring payment from the Chargent Anywhere Payment Console, an ‘Update Recurring’ button would appear instead of the ‘Next’ button, which prevented the completion of the process.

Known Issues and Problems

Strong Customer Authentication (SCA) Not Available in Take Payment Component within a Screen Flow

As Salesforce does not allow the use of iframes within a Screen Flow, the SCA workflow cannot be triggered from the Take Payment Component when configured within a Screen Flow. **All transactions that require the SCA workflow must be conducted from the Experience Cloud (but not within a Flow) or a Sites page, such as Payment Request.**
